



**PROFILE: JEFF KLEIN

Southern-California-born Jeff Klein always knew he would be an inventor. And his family's love of poker ensured that almost anything he created would be poker-related.

Throughout his childhood, Jeff enjoyed the role of railbird (someone who watches poker play) during his father's monthly game, comprised of college buddies, which spanned a 20-year period. At only 12 years old, Jeff joined in his family's traditional game play at Thanksgiving and Christmas gatherings. His aunt and uncle were so dedicated to the game they designed their own monogrammed clay poker chips.

In high school, Jeff and his brother would often stay up all night playing poker, but in college, Jeff could never find a game.

In 2003, Jeff was introduced to Texas Hold'em and never looked back. He began to play weekly at the Portland Rounders Club, where he met the owner and manager, Rob Rae.

Prior to founding DB Dealer, Inc., Jeff was a partner of a health insurance brokerage firm, and had previously served as an independent health insurance agent. Earlier in his career, Jeff was the vice president of Rode Brothers Hardwood Flooring.

Most recently, Klein entered the income property business, investing in two apartment buildings in the Portland metro area. He became a founding partner of DB Dealer, Inc. in early 2005.
