

## And The New Light Heavyweight Champion Of The World ... Gavin Smith!

On May 15, 2004, Antonio Tarver scored a stunning second-round knockout of the great Mike Tyson to become the undisputed light heavyweight champion of the boxing world. But on January 29, 2006, Tarver found himself in the unfamiliar role of knockout

victim—at the hands of a 37-year-old, somewhat overweight Canadian who, as the old cliché goes, probably doesn't know a left hook from a fish hook.

"I actually crippled Tarver first, and then took him out," Smith explained. "I'm just glad Antonio Tarver didn't knock me out after I knocked him out."

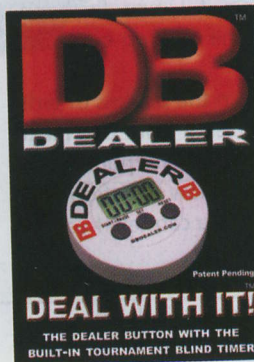
